DEFINITIONS

¹ **Number of Students Who Began Program** means the number of students who began a program who are scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year, and includes all the students who remained enrolled after their cancellation period.

² **Number of Students Who Completed Program** means the number of students who began their program minus the students who were terminated or withdrew before their scheduled program completion date.

³ **Completion Rate** is the number of students who completed their scheduled program divided by the number of students who began.

⁴ **Students Available for Graduation** means the total number of students available to complete a program of four terms ending at the High Advanced level.

⁵ **Number of Graduates** means the number of students who passed the High Advanced level and completed a program of at least 4 terms within 100% of the published program length.
